Message from Mr Truby

What a beautiful Friday morning!

As we come to the end of our fourth week of term, I am left wondering where the time has gone. However, I am delighted to say that, in school, we are continuing to move forwards positively.

This week, we have been observing the mathematics lessons and we are already seeing the positive impact that the six part lessons are having on both learning and engagement during lessons. The children are becoming increasingly confident in using mathematical equipment and manipulatives to support their learning, which will lead to greater conceptual understanding. It has also been extremely positive to see how the focus on classroom culture, linked to the core values, is impacting on the climate for learning across school.

Temporary Classroom

An extraordinary meeting of the Full Governing Body took place this week to consider the future of the temporary classroom. As you may be aware, the school has been unsuccessful in its application for funding to replace this on a number of occasions, which is very disappointing.

The governors have decided to make one final application for funding to replace this temporary classroom. It was also decided that, if funding cannot be secured, this would need to be funded using the school's reserves.

This work would need to be completed during the summer holidays. In the meantime, the conditions in the temporary classroom are being monitored on a daily basis; dehumidifiers and additional heating are in place, particularly during the night, to ensure appropriate environmental conditions.

Should the conditions become unsuitable for the children at any stage during the year, this class would need to be relocated elsewhere in the school site and various options are being considered. This is a high priority for the school and the Governing Body.
