A big thank you also and well done to the children, who behaved beautifully and were fantastic at looking after each other.

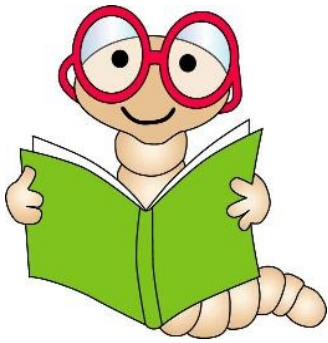


Fireworks Spectacular

This is run by parent volunteers and if you are able to offer any help please let Ms McKerrow know as soon as possible.

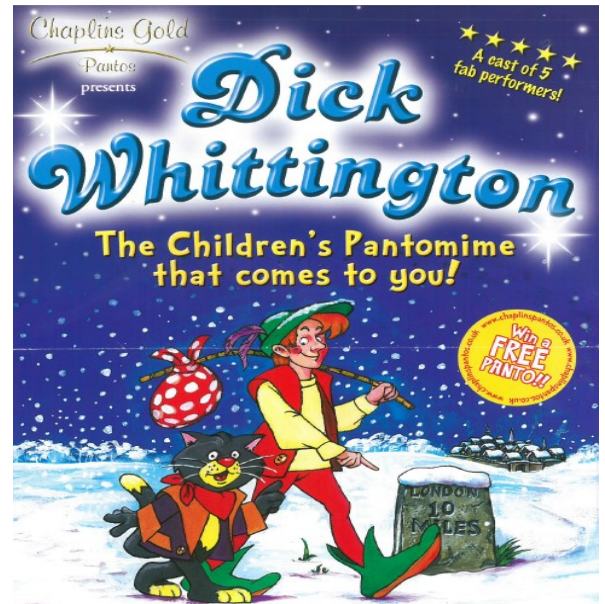
PTA News
