Finally, I would like to wish all of our Year 6 children the very best of luck for the SATs next week. I am very confident that they will do extremely well because they have worked incredibly hard.

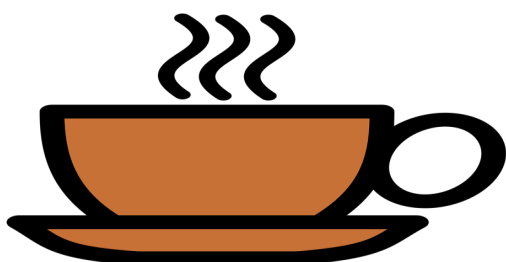
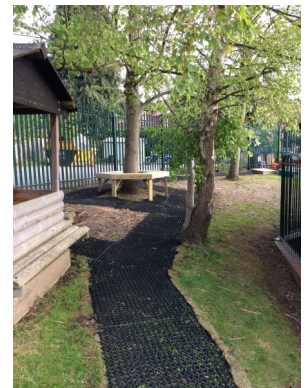

### Last date for ordering School Uniform

In order for us to offer a high level of service to all our schools, we ask that any orders required for school delivery before the summer break are received by: **Friday the 9th of June 2017 for GUARANTEED SCHOOL DELIVERY.** We will try to fulfil any orders received after this date as far as is reasonably possible.

### **Orders placed after the 9<sup>th</sup> of June 2017:**

We can still accept orders after this date. We will try our hardest to deliver these orders to school before the summer break. If the items are needed for September, we can offer a collection from our office during the summer break or a home delivery at additional cost of £3.95 up to 4 items and £6.95 for 5 items and above. Free home delivery on orders of £120. Parents must state collection for Logo Leisurewear and a contact telephone number or include any additional payment for postage if required.

Many schools are set up for online orders. The last guaranteed date for online orders for home delivery or collection will be 31<sup>st</sup> July but we will try to process what we can after that date to cover late places etc.

If your new starter event is after this date can you let us know and we can get in touch to arrange a specific one off bulk new starter collection and delivery date.

We can also arrange a delivery into school during the summer break (by prior arrangement with the school)

**We ask that parents are made aware of this to allow them time to place their orders in sufficient time.** This will also allow for any exchanges to be made if wrong colour or size is ordered.

Please can you complete the slip to inform us of your anticipated number of new starters for September 2017. This information will greatly help us in planning stock and production.
