Numbers permitting, from September there will be two after school Infant Art Clubs per week, one on a Monday and one on a Tuesday, 3.30pm till 5.00pm.

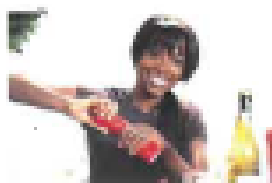
