

Performance Data 2023

Please see below our school outcomes from the national assessments at the end of the academic year 2022-2023 (July 2023). There were no national assessments in 2020 or 2021 due to Covid.

The outcomes are shown as whether children have achieved the expected standard for their age, or not achieved this standard. At the end of Key Stage 1 (Year 2) and Key Stage 2 (Year 6), some children also achieved a higher standard, or 'greater depth'.

While they do not by any means give a full picture of a school, these outcomes are what is used to compare schools with national averages, and in national and local 'performance tables'.
