



## School Uniform Policy

**ALL clothing should be clearly labelled with the child's name**

<b>Polo Shirt</b>  <b>or</b>  <b>Shirt &amp; Tie</b>	Short sleeved polo shirt, royal blue  or  Sky blue shirt worn with a royal blue and gold striped school tie. (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils can wear the elasticated tie)
<b>Sweatshirt, sweat-cardi, knitted jumper or cardigan</b>	Royal blue, with the school logo
<b>Dress</b>	Blue and white checked (only for the Summer Term and September to October half term if the weather is hot)
<b>Trousers</b>	Mid grey
<b>Shorts</b>	Mid grey - knee length
<b>Skirt</b>	Mid grey - knee length
<b>Pinafore</b>	Mid grey - knee length
<b>Socks/tights</b>	Socks - white or grey / tights - grey
<b>Shoes.</b>	Plain black, no visible logos
<b>Jewellery</b>	Children may only wear a pair of stud earrings and a watch: No hooped earrings, necklaces, rings or bracelets are allowed. No marks/cuts allowed in eyebrows. <i>For Health and Safety reasons children may not participate in PE if wearing earrings. Please ensure that they can remove them themselves or do not wear them on day of PE or swimming.</i>
<b>Hair</b>	The school does not allow extremes of hair fashion i.e. no lines, cuts, patterns, shaved heads, or obvious dyeing of the hair. Hair should look natural. Hair must be kept tidy in the interests of safety (long hair tied back). Please check with school first if you are unsure.
<b>Coat</b>	Coats are a personal choice, but hoodies, sweatshirts and denim jackets are not considered to be coats. There is the option to purchase a school coat from our uniform provider (Logo Leisurewear).
<b>PE KIT</b>	
<b>T-shirt</b>	Plain in house colour
<b>Shorts</b>	Plain black
<b>Hoodie / sweatshirt / tracksuit top</b>	Plain black /navy blue or royal blue
<b>Jogging bottoms</b>	Plain black or navy blue
<b>Trainers</b>	(Clean) for outdoor lessons
<b>Hair</b>	To be tied up during PE lessons
